The Championship will consist of five races, two to be held on Saturday 18th June and three on Sunday 19th. See the race programme for times and full details

A welcome barbecue will be held from 7pm on Friday evening at the NBYC clubhouse and there will be a three course Championship Dinner on Saturday night, again at the clubhouse. A special advance booking package deal is available to include race entry, two tickets for the barbecue and two tickets for the dinner – to benefit from this you must return your entry forms with payment by **Saturday 11**th **June**.

Arrangements will be made with Horning Sailing Club to provide tows from Horning to Wroxham, and crane and slipway facilities are available at Wroxham to launch boats arriving by road.

NOTICE OF RACE

RULES: The Championship will be governed by the current Racing Rules of Sailing, the prescriptions of the RYA, the Notice of Race, the rules of the Classes and by the Sailing Instructions of Norfolk Broads Yacht Club.

SAILING INSTRUCTIONS: The Sailing Instructions of Norfolk Broads Yacht Club are available from the Club Manager or from the NBYC website www.nbyc.co.uk under Programmes.

VENUE & TIMINGS: The racing will take place on Wroxham Broad on 18th and 19th June 2016. The first race on Saturday is at 13.30, the second at 15.30. Sunday morning third race is at 10.30, the fourth race at 13.10, and the final race as soon as possible after race 4. There will be a briefing in the Clubhouse at 12 noon on Saturday. Races will not be started before the stated times, however they may be delayed at the discretion of the Duty Race Officer.

ELIGIBILITY: Entry is open to any Yeoman or Kinsman conforming to class rules. All championship helms must be fully paid up members of the Yeoman & Kinsman Association. Only boats declaring non-Spinnaker on the entry form or notifying the Race Officer of their status in writing at least 30 minutes before the start of Race 1 will be eligible for the Non-Spinnaker Trophy.

FEES: The entry fee is £15 together with completion of the entry form. Entries will be accepted before the warning signal of the first race in which the boat competes.

SCORING: Scoring shall be in accordance with NBYC Sailing Instructions.

INSURANCE: Each participating boat shall have valid third party liability insurance with a minimum cover of £2,000,000.

DISCLAIMERS: A boat is entirely responsible for her own safety, whether afloat or ashore, and nothing, in the Notice of Race or Sailing Instructions or anywhere else, reduces this responsibility. If using a borrowed or rented boat, it is the responsibility of the competitor to determine equipment condition, redress under rule 62.1a will not be allowed.

Advertising may only be displayed as approved by the organising authority.

CRANE: There are craning and slipway facilities available to launch and recover visiting boats. If this facility is required please contact the Club Manager who will be able to make arrangements. manager@nbyc.co.uk 01603 782808.

RYA RISK STATEMENT

Rule 4 of the Racing Rules of Sailing states: "The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue racing is hers alone."

Sailing is by its nature an unpredictable sport and therefore involves an element of risk. By taking part in the event, each competitor agrees and acknowledges that:

- a) They are aware of the inherent element of risk involved in the sport and accept responsibility for the exposure of themselves, their crew and their boat to such inherent risk whilst taking part in the event;
- b) They are responsible for the safety of themselves, their crew, their boat and their other property whether afloat or ashore;
- They accept responsibility for any injury, damage or loss to the extent caused by their own actions or omissions;
- d) Their boat is in good order, equipped to sail in the event and they are fit to participate;
- e) The provision of a race management team, patrol boats, umpires and other officials and volunteers by the organiser does not relieve them of their own responsibilities;
- f) The provision of patrol boat cover is limited to such assistance, particularly in extreme weather conditions, as can be practically provided in the circumstances;
